Sign in to the TelNet Digital Fax Web Portal

- 1. Visit https://www.telnetfax.com/
- 2. Sign in with your assigned TelNet Digital Fax username (your email address) and password.
- 3. Click Sign In






Send fax using TelNet Digital Fax web portal

1. In the left navigation menu, click Fax 1 and then click the Fax 2 submenu.

Complete The Steps Below

- 1. Enter Fax Number 3 of recipient.
- 2. Select desired Cover Page. 4
- 3. Enter name of person or organization that you are sending the fax to in the **Deliver To** 5 field.
- 4. Enter **Subject** 6 and **Notes** 7 if applicable.
- 5. Add desired file(s) in the **Attachments** 3 section (click in field or drag & drop file).







View Fax History


1. In left navigation, click Fax oand then click the History submenu




A list of recent inbound and outbound faxes will be displayed.



Select the desired fax and click the **ellipses** near the far right 2. Click **ViewPrint** to display the fax 3.





NOTE: Several additional options are available in the submenu to Download, Resend, view detailed Info and Delete faxes There are also several options on the right side of the fax to rotate, zoom, print, etc.


Click any of the column headings to sort faxes by **Date**, **Direction**, etc.

Search for Faxes


In the left navigation, click **Fax** 4 then click the **History** 5 submenu.



Type desired fax number in the **Search** field at top navigation and press **enter**. This can be a subset of the fax number.

Click the down arrow in the upper right corner to search by **Date Range 17**, **Status 18** or **Tag 19**.

Near the upper right corner, click All 20, Inbound 21 or Outbound 22 options to display/filter faxes by direction.






Cover Pages

In the left navigation, click Fax 23then click the Cover Page 24submenu.



Several system cover pages are provided. Click the desired system template to preview the layout. Click the **Create new** option to create a customized cover page.


Select an existing template as a starting point or choose the option to **Create from scratch** 25. Enter name for cover page

In the left navigation near the lower left corner, click your **Avatar** 27. Click **Your Settings** 28 near the top of the left navigation.








In the top navigation, click the **Profile** tab. Use this tab to update items such as **Name** and **Email** address and also set Color mode 31.




In the top navigation, click the Security 22 tab. Use this tab to update Password 33 and for added security, enable Two-Factor Authentication 34.

In the top navigation, click the Fax 55 tab. Use this tab to update Caller ID 56 information and change Email Notifications 57 settings



Contacts

In the left navigation near bottom, click **Contacts** 3. Click the **Create** 3 button near the upper right corner to add contacts. Enter **Name** 4 and **Fax number** 4. Press **Create** 2 to add the contact. The contact can later be selected from a list when sending faxes.


HIPAA Compliance

For added security, it is recommended to not send fax content via email. Click **Your Settings** 43, and then click the **Fax** 44 tab. Disable the settings below:

- · Send email body as an attachment
- Include Copy of Sent Fax
- · Include Copy of Received Fax

Note: that email notifications that a fax was sent or received (without including actual fax content/pages) are still acceptable.

Note: refer to customer sys admin guide to modify settings for all users within your organization.

Fax Using Email

Sending Fax using email

- 1. In Outlook, Gmail, or your preferred email client, open a new email message.
- 2. Enter the fax number@fax.telnetfax.com (e.g.,12485551234@fax.telnetfax.com) in the recipient field. Enter 1 + the 10 digit fax number. Eleven digits must be used, or your fax will not be sent.
- 3. Enter information: The subject of the email will be the subject on the cover sheet. The body of the email will be the cover page notes you want to send.
- 4. You may also attach the file you want to fax. Supported file types include TIFF, GIF, PNG, JPEG, PDF, DOC, DOCX, XLS, XLSX, PPT, PPTX, TXT and RTF.
- 5. Press Send.

Receiving Fax using email

- In Outlook, Gmail, or your preferred email client, simply access your inbox to view faxes as they become available.
- 2. View email and open attachment.

Note: The email address used to log into an email client must match the username / email that is set in the TelNet Digital Fax web portal. If they don't match, users will not be able to send outbound faxes from within email clients such as Gmail, Outlook, Yahoo, etc.

Send fax from your fax machine using a TelNet Fax Bridge Adapter

- 1. If you have installed a TelNet Fax Bridge Adapter on your fax machine to enable digital fax service, simply put your document in the fax machine.
- 2. Dial the 11-digit, fully-qualified fax number (1 + area code + fax number).
- 3. Press the Send button.
- 4. Look for an email notification with fax success or failure message
